

ACHIEVEMENTS OF CID(CRIME) IN 2015

1. SPECIAL NARCOTICS POLICE STATION:

In the year 2015, Special Narcotics Police Station, under SP CID (Crime), launched a massive campaign against Narcotics and Psychotropic Substances in the state of Mizoram. Through concerted coordination with NGO (Central Young Mizo Association), sister agencies and engagement of sources, Spl. Narcotics PS has made significant seizures in the year 2015. Much effort has been put in to address the recent trend of smuggling of Pseudoephedrine from Mizoram to Myanmar and the reverse inflow of the lethal drug, methamphetamine, from Myanmar into India through Mizoram. Remarkable achievements have been made in this regard where in Spl Narcotics PS has seized a total of 163.338 kgs (41,70,400 tabs) of Pseudoephedrine meant for export and a total of 31.266 kgs (2,54,400 tabs) of Methamphetamine which entered Mizoram from Myanmar. In the year 2015 a total of 30 cases have been registered and 43 persons have been arrested including 7 foreigners.

Spl. Narcotics Police Station is also actively involved in detection and seizure of Fake Indian Currency Notes (FICN) and Arms and Ammunition. Considerable achievements have also been made in this regard: The details of drugs, FICN, arms and ammunition seized by Special Narcotics PS during the year 2015 is shown below:

2. CRIME AND CRIMINAL TRACKING NETWORK SYSTEM (CCTNS) PROJECT

Implementation of CCTNS Project, Mizoram is taken up by CID Crime unit and considerable achievements have made in the project. Despite challenges such as erratic connectivity, frequent power failures and occasional software related issues, the CCTNS Project in Mizoram is progress and is continuously monitored and supervised by CID Crime. The achievements in CCTNS Project during the year 2015 are as follows:

- a) As on 04th Jan, 2016 a total number of General Diary: 162038, IIF1:3119, IIF2:3379, IIF3: 505, IIF4:299, IIF5:315 entries have been synched from Police Stations to CCTNS DC Server at State Data Centre. In addition to this, a large number of entries made in remote offline police stations are yet to be synched with the Data Centre when connectivity issue is resolved.
- b) Legacy files of cases between the years 2002 - 2012 have been digitized and verified. Migration of digitized files into the state data centre is in progress.
- c) As per directions and approval from MHA/NCRB, procurement of new Router and Switch has been made for sharing of Mizoram CCTNS data with the Centre and vice versa through the NIC National Knowledge Network (NKN).
- d) CCTNS Help Desk set up in SCRB provides technical assistance to Police Stations and monitors Operation and Maintenance of all CCTNS sites.
- e) Joint Inspection of CCTNS connectivity and hardware at Sadar Police Stations and District Training Centre was conducted in all 8 (eight) districts by team from CID (Crime) led by DySP, CID (Crime), System Integrator and representatives of BSNL in December ,2015.

3. ECONOMIC OFFENCES WING (EOW):

The Economic Offence Wing under SP CID Crime is actively engaged in conducting investigation and enquiries into complaints relating to economic offences received from private persons, Finance Intelligence Unit, India (FIU-IND) and other sources. EOW in coordination with Reserve Bank of India also monitors Non Banking Financial Institutions (NBFCs) and Un-Incorporated Bodies (UIB) in the state to prevent violation of license conditions and other offences. The achievements of Economic Offence Wing during 2015 are as follows:

- a. **41 (Forty one)** Nos. of Suspicious Transaction Reports (STRs) were received from FIU-IND during 2015 and out of which, 32 Nos. were finalized and report submitted.
- b. **5 (five)** Nos. of Private complaints/Bank frauds related complaints have been received from other agency/individuals during 2015 which are enquired and out of which **4 (four)** Nos. were finalized.
- c. **9 (Nine)** Nos. of Company/Firms/Market Business Company have been identified and monitored to ensure safety of public depositors. Within the effected period, 1(one) Company in violation of law i.e accepting public deposits without any required valid permission from the Competent Authority was verified/enquired and the case has been referred to the Reserve Bank of India and other Regulatory Authority of Central Government for initiating necessary action against the defaulter.
- d. **1 (one)** No. of complaint against money fraud and is being investigated have been taken up by EOW under Mizoram PID Act 2002.

4. ANTI HUMAN TRAFFICKING UNIT (AHTU)

- a) **Operation Smile** : - In pursuance of Govt. of India directives and as the Nodal Officer of Anti-Human Trafficking in Mizoram, SP, CID Crime coordinated, monitored 'Operation Smile-I', a campaign to identify missing children, conducted during the month of January 2015. A dedicated campaign of identification screening and documentation of Children in 36 (thirty six) Shelter homes/ Orphanages at eight districts with a total population of 902 (nine hundred and two) children have been conducted through District Superintendents of Police and Social Welfare Department Officers. 1 (one) missing child was identified in this campaign.
- b) **Operation Muskaan** : :- In pursuance of Govt. of India directives, a statewide campaign on tracking of Missing Children, 'Operation Muskaan', was again conducted in all the 8 (eight) Districts of Mizoram in the month of July, 2015. The operation was coordinated and monitored by SP CID Crime, Nodal Officer of Anti Human Trafficking Unit. Further, a large scale awareness programme has also been conducted by CID (Crime) Office where Awareness Generation material on Missing Children and Human Trafficking has been issued to 80 (eighty) schools in Mizoram and to 150 (one hundred and fifty) Young Mizo Association (YMA) Branches for further circulation and publishing in their local Newsletters. YMA is the largest NGO in Mizoram and comprises of almost all Mizos above the age of 14 (fourteen). This awareness campaign is expected to have far reaching effect throughout the state of Mizoram.

5. TRAININGS CONDUCTED

- a) 3(Three) days Orientation Course on CCTNS was conducted at SCRB Training Hall for Senior Police Officers of the rank of Dy. SP to SP during 9.3.2015 - 11.3.2015.
- b) 1(one) week Orientation Course on CCTNS was conducted for Dy. SP Probationers at SCRB Training Hall during 31.8.2015 to 3.9.2015.
- c) One day workshop on 'Investigation and prosecution of cases under ND&PS Act and related issues' for Officers and staff of Special Narcotic Police Station was held on 12th October, 2015 at SCRB Training Hall. Pu Lalchhandama, Addl. Public Prosecutor and Pi Lalrinpuii, Addl. Public Prosecutor were utilized as Resource Persons. All

Investigating Officers of Special Narcotic Police Station and Staff from CID (Crime) attended the Workshop.

- d) Pu Stephen Lalrinawma, Addl. SP CID Crime conducted a 1 (one) Day Training on Packing and Sealing of Recovered drugs at the SCRB Training Hall on 17th December, 2015 for 32 police officers from CID (SB).
- e) One day Workshop on 'Pending Cases of ND&PS Act and its related matters/issues' was held on 16th October, 2015 at SCRB Training Hall. Pu T. Lalropuia, Dy. Director, FSL was utilized as Resource Person and all Investigating Officers of Special Narcotic Police Station attended the workshop.

6. AWARENESS PROGRAMMES

- a) Pu Joseph Lalchhuana, the then SP Crime and Pu Zonun Sanga, Dy. SP CID Crime served as Resource person for "Seminar on Cyber Crime" jointly organized by Govt. Saitual College, Saitual and Synod Social Front, Siatual Chhimveng on 14th February 2015.
- b) Pu Lallianmawia, SP CID Crime delivered a presentation on Drug Trafficking in Mizoram on the occasion of International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking on 26th June 2015.
- c) Pu Zonun Sanga, DySP CID Crime served as Resource Person for Human Trafficking, Cyber Crime and Road Traffic Awareness at the Life Skills Development Programme held at The Regional Institute of Paramedical & Nursing Sciences (RIPANS) on 27th July, 2015.
- d) Pu Zonun Sanga, DySP CID Crime delivered a lecture on "Cyber Crime Awareness and Human Trafficking Concept and Trends in Mizoram" at the Deptt. Of Mass Communication, Mizoram University on 19th October 2015.
- e) Pu Lallianmawia, SP CID Crime delivered a talk on "Mihring hmanga sumdawnngte laka fimkhur dan tur" at All India Radio, Aizawl on 9th December 2015.
- f) Pu Lalliamnawia, SP CID Crime and Pu Zonun Sanga, DySP CID Crime conducted a live phone in programme on Cyber Crime Awareness at the All India Radio, Aizawl on 26th December 2015.

7. GAMES AND SPORTS

- a) Pu Lallianmawia, SP CID Crime, led the Mizoram Police Shooting Team at the 9th All India Police Shooting Championship, 2015 at Kadarapur Firing Range and at the 16th All India Police Shooting (AIPDM) Competition, 2015 held at Diphu, Assam.
- b) Pu Stephen Lalrinawma, Addl. SP CID Crime, won a Silver Medal at the 8th All India Police Badminton Meet 2015 in the Men's Double Category.
- c) SI H Lalnunmawia and SI Lalramdina won Bronze Medals in Volleyball and Const. H Zakima, Const. Rohnuna and Const C Lalhrwaitluanga won Bronze Medals in Hockey at the XVI Mizoram Police Sports Meet, 2015.
