

## MONTHLY RETURN OF GOOD STORIES OF CHAMPHAI DISTRICT

1. On 13.01.2018, a written suo moto FIR was received from SI Jerry LD Poonte, i/c, DSB Champhai to the effect that on 13.01.2018 @ 3:00pm, 10th AR Zokhawthar, Assam Rifles Field Intelligence Unit (ARFIU) and DSB Champhai conducted checking on the border of Zokhawthar along Tiau river on the basis of information received from source. Therefore, at about 6:30pm, two persons came with a black polythene on foot and arrest one of them Ngosianliana (29) s/o Suankhawpau of Khawmawi, Myanmar after a brief struggle while the other person managed to escape. After that thorough checking was conducted by following all formalities and recovered 30 soap cases weighing 423 grams suspected to be heroin worth Rs. 15,00,000/- (approx). Hence, Champhai-PS C/No. 3/2018 dt. 13.01.2018 u/s 21 (C) ND & PS Act r/w 14 Foreigner Act was registered.
2. On 25.01.2018, a written FIR was received from SI Zirthanga Pachuau Sector Officer, CID (SB), Champhai stating that on 25.01.2018 @ 10:13am, he along with party conducted confidential duty at Zokhawthar road between Melbuk and Mualkawi, they stopped one maxi cab B/R. No. MZ-04- 1199 driven by Benjamin Malsawmtluanga (24) s/o Rualliankhuma of electric veng, Champhai coming from Zokhawthar side was checked and found one rack sack bag containing 20 soap cases of white/ yellow powder suspected to be heroin no - 4 weighing 264.7grams worth Rs. 10,00,000/- in local market belonging to Vansuiem (36) @ Tetei d/o Biaknghillo of Tuilum village, Falam District, Myanmar(.) Hence, Champhai-PS C/No.7/2018 DT.25.1.2018 U/S 21 (C) ND & PS Act r/w 14 Foreigner Act was registered.
3. On 31.01.2018, a written FIR was received from SI Jerry LD Poonte, i/c, DSB Champhai to the effect that on Dt. 31.01.2018 they received reliable information from source that some contraband was coming from Hnahlan towards Champhai and conducted joint operation with 10th AR, Champhai and Assam Rifles Field Intelligence Unit (ARFIU) by conducting mobile checking at about 10:00am, they halted one sumo B/R No. MZ-01-J-9673 and conducted checking after following all formalities under ND & PS Act and recovered two white plastic bags and one green hold-all containing seeds and flowering tops suspected to be ganja weighing 51.6kgs worth about Rs.2,50,000/- (two lakhs fifty thousand) only from the possession of Ralkhuma Chhangte (46) s/o C.Thuamkunga of Hnahlan Saron Veng. The suspected ganja was seized by following all formalities by preparing grounds of belief and other mandatory procedure. Hence, Champhai- PS C/NO. 9/2018 Dt. 31.01.2018 U/S 20 (C) ND & PS Act was registered.

## POSITIVE STORIES / GOOD WORKS BEING DONE IN MAMIT DISTRICT

### I. SUCCESSFUL INVESTIGATION OF AUTO THEFT BY KANH MUN PS:

#### CASE REFERENCE:-

- Kanhmun P.S. Case No.1/2018 dt.1.1.2018 u/s 380 IPC.

#### GIST OF FIR:-

On 1.1.2018. a written FIR was lodged by Pi Rochansangi w/o Biakchungnunga of Kanhmun to the effect that on 1.1.2018 at around 3:00 Am, her Scooty, Ray-Z (Red and Black colour), Registration No. MZ-08-2571, Chassis No. MEI2NCO11E2094487, Engine No. 2NC1094506, value of Rs.59,500/- had been stolen by unknown person and she requested to take necessary action for recovery of the stolen vehicle and against the miscreant. Hence, the case was registered and ASI C.Biakthianghlima of Kanhmun PS was entrusted to investigate the case.

#### Achievement and Completion of the case investigation:-

During investigation, all out efforts have been taken by the 10 and Kanhmun PS staff for detection of this clueless case. As a result, the case was successfully detected on 4.1.2018 and caused arrest of the accused person, namely; Tea (22) s/o Bidipa Reang of Kanhmun village. The stolen vehicle YAMAHA Ray-Z was also recovered on 4.1.2018 from Nilambazar, Assam before it was disposed by the accused.

After all the formalities have been observed, the case was charge sheeted on 12.1.2018 vide CS No.1/18 Dt.12.1.18 u/s 380 IPC and the said accused person was sent up to the Court of GM, Mamit to face his trial.

The case is under trial at present in the court of CJM, Mamit.

## II. SUCCESSFUL INVESTIGATION OF ARSON CASE BY KAWRTHAH PS:

### CASE REFERENCE:-

- Kawrthah P.S. Case No.1/2018 dt.22.1.2018 u/s 436, 457 IPC.

### GIST OF FIR:-

On 22.1.18, a written FIR was lodged by K. Wilson s/o Kumaravel (L), Principal, Govt. Kawrthah Higher Secondary School stating that some unknown miscreants had entered into their School Office building by breaking the window bars and set the building on fire causing destructions/damages of different properties of the school which amounted to Rs.3,71,850/- approximately. He requested to detect the case and take legal action against the miscreants. Hence, the case was registered and SI H.Lalengliana of Kawrthah PS was entrusted to investigate the case.

### Achievement and Completion of the case investigation:-

The case, though a clueless one, was promptly investigated by the 10 and his party under the close supervision of SDPO, Kawrthah. All out efforts have been given for detection of the unknown culprit from all the possible corners. As a result, the case was successfully detected and the real culprit namely Vanlalthlamuanpuia (17yrs) s/o Lalchunglura of Kawrtethawveng village, who is a student of Class XII, Govt. Kawrthah Higher Secondary School was apprehended. He admitted his involvement before Police and confessed the entire incidents during interrogation. He was, therefore, forwarded to the Principal, JJB, Mamit on the same day, i.e. 27.1.2018.

The case is, therefore, treated as disposed of.
