On 6.3.2018 @12:28AM, a joint team consisting DSB Champhai, 10th Assam Rifles and ARFIU detained one female person Biaknemi (32) D/o Kaphnuna of Kanan veng, Champhai who was riding on Scooty B/R No.MZ 04 9721 on suspicious ground at Champhai, Vengthlang near Presbyterian Church and recovered brown powder suspected to be heroin weighing 134 grams worth Rs.5,00,000/- from her illegal possession. Hence, Champhai-PS C/No. 19/2018 dt. 2.3.2018 u/s 21 (b) ND & PS Act was registered.

On 27.3.2018 @ 10:00 AM, Quarterly Crime Review Meeting with AD & SJ, Public Prosecutors was held at Champhai PS Conference Hall under the Chairmanship of the Superintendent of Police, Champhai District, Champhai. 12 (Twelve) nos of pending SR cases and 14 (Fourteen) nos of pending Non-SR cases were discussed and instructions were issued against each case. Important points to strengthen the prosecution were also highlighted.

SEIZURE OF 2060 NOS. OF AK-47 (7.62 mm) LIVE AMMUNITION BY WEST PHAILENG POLICE

CASE REFERENCE:- W.Phaileng PS C/No.6/18 Dt.26.3.2018 u/s 25(1AA) Arms Act r/w 34 IPC.

Brief story of the case:-

On the night of Dt. 25.03.2018 acting on specific intelligence input, a team of West Phaileng Police led by Pu Zarzoliana, SDPO, W.Phaileng recovered and seized 2060 (two thousand and sixty) numbers of live ammunitions from the illegal possession of two persons namely (i) Vanramthanga (42) S/o K. Saikhupa of Tlabung, Lunglei District and (ii) D. Lallaizauva (26) S/o D. Lalthangliana of Hunthar, Aizawl. The two suspected were intercepted at the outskirts of Dapchhuah on the night of Dt.25.3.2018 at around 9:45 p.m. while they were proceeding toward Bangladesh by availing motorcycle B/R. No. MZ-01-P-9795. The two suspected arms smugglers along with their motorcycle and 3 (three) rucksacks were brought to YMA Hall, Dapchhuah. Checking was conducted in presence of reliable witnesses from Dapchhuah village. During the checking, 2060 (two thousand and sixty) numbers of live ammunitions of AK-47 (7.62 mm) were recovered and seized from the possession of the two armed smugglers. The estimated cost of the seized ammunitions was about Rs. 1,277,200/- approximately.

The two accused persons were brought to West Phaileng Police Station and they were thoroughly interrogated. The accused persons were properly arrested and a case vide West Phaileng Police Station Case No.6/2018 Dt.26.3.2018-U/s 25 (1AA) Arms Act r/w 34 IPC had been registered and SI Lalsangbera Sailo, Officer-In-Charge, West Phaileng PS was endorsed to investigate the case.

Conclusion:-

The case is under investigation. The two accused persons were forwarded to CJM, Mamit with a prayer to remand them into judicial custody and they were detaining in District Jail, Mamit.
