APPEAL TO THOSE SEEKING EMPLOYMENT IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES


Nowadays many youths from Mizoram seek employment (mostly as domestic workers) in China and other foreign countries such as Singapore, Malaysia leh Macau .etc and many are already working in these countries. However, there have been various instances where residents of Mizoram (Indian Nationals) have been apprehended on charges of illegal entry and on the basis of their inability to produce valid/required documents to ply trade/work. Some of these victims possess fake Myanmarse passports illegally, which hinder the process of their deportation back to India even after legal formalities have been completed.

Hence, Mizoram Police fervently requests and appeals to the public and those seeking employment in foreign countries to kindly refrain from engaging in such illegal activities and to pursue employment in foreign countries through legal channels only.
