PRESS RELEASE

With an aim to curtail stolen mobile phone market and discourage mobile phone thefts, protect consumers' interests and facilitate law enforcement authorities, Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communication, Govt. of India, has implemented the Central Equipment Identity Registry (CEIR), that connects to the IMEI database of all mobile operators. CEIR acts as a Central system for all network operators to share blacklisted mobile devices, so that the devices blacklisted in one network will not work on other networks even if the Subscriber Identity Module (SIM) card in the device is changed.

Through this system, which has been made available to Mizoram, any consumer whose mobile phone has been stolen or lost, can lodge requests online at (ceir.gov.in) or through police authorities at the Police Station for blocking of lost mobile handset. Later police authorities can track (with location details) the use of this blocked handset, if anyone tries to use it, thereby helping authorities in tracking of the lost handset.

Mizoram Police appeals to the public to make use of Central Equipment Identity Register and to approach the Police Station for any assistance in this regard. We are always there to help you and committed to better public service delivery.
