

PRESS STATEMENT

Date: 23.7.2023

In response to the Young Mizo Association (YMA) led NGO Coordination Committee (NGOCC)'s proposed solidarity protest march on July 25 (Tuesday) to express support with the Kuki-Zo community in Manipur, DGP Mizoram, Pu Anil Shukla IPS, convened a review meeting on 22.7.2023 (Saturday) at his office chamber. The meeting was attended by senior police officers, and focused on assessing security arrangements and deployments. Additionally, all measures taken to ensure the safety and security of Manipuri people/Meitei in various parts of Mizoram were thoroughly reviewed.

During the meeting, DGP Mizoram directed to ensure proper deployment, patrolling, and vigilance in all districts, especially in vulnerable areas, to prevent any untoward incidents. He emphasized the need for a sufficient number of reserve forces with vehicles and officers to facilitate quick deployment and response in case of any incident within their areas.

Following the meeting, DGP Mizoram and the team of senior police officials visited the proposed site locations in Aizawl, namely Chanmari on the north side, Kulikawn on the south side, and Raj Bhavan North Gate, where the Procession is scheduled to take place for an on-ground review and assessment.

The Mizoram Police, in collaboration with administrative officials, is maintaining a close watch on the situation. Senior Police Officers and all police personnel on the ground are working diligently to ensure the safety and security of Manipuri people/Meitei in various parts of Mizoram.

While the Mizoram Police is committed to protecting all citizens and upholding communal harmony, we urge all CSOs, NGOs, and the general public, known for their law-abiding and peace-loving nature, to assist us in maintaining peace and tranquility.
